

GUIDELINES FOR YOUR FLORIST

Flowers and floral decorations in the church are for the altar and/or window boxes and are left for the church following the ceremony.

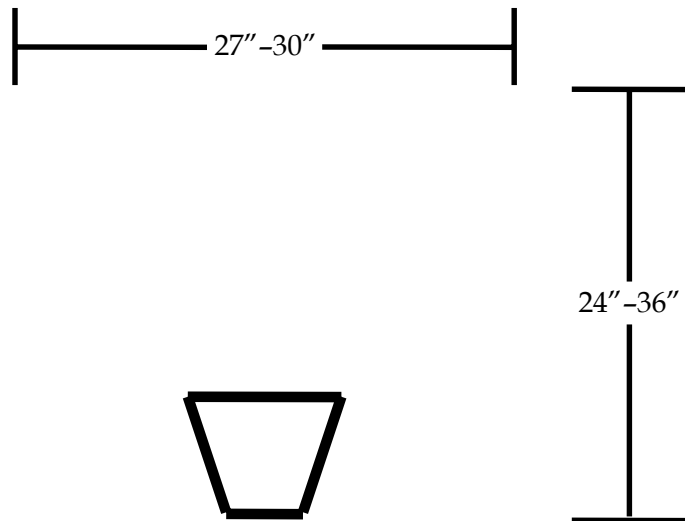
• Flower Arrangements at the Altar

Two identical arrangements should be three-sided, since one is placed up against the wall on each side of the high altar. They should be in #5] papier-mâché container liners, ready to insert into our vases.

From the base of the liner, the flowers should measure:

27" to 30" wide

24" to 36" high



This is the inner liner which is placed in the vases. The pedestal of the vase adds another 4" to the overall height.

• Window Boxes (optional)

We have 9 large window boxes (8 boxes for the nave, an optional box for the sanctuary; none by the organ). They measure 29" x 5" x 5"; the screen inserts hold 3 standard-sized blocks of oasis. There is a narrower box for the window in the narthex. Boxes may not be taken from the church for arranging. Small potted plants instead of cut flowers work well.

• Preferred Delivery Time

A member of the altar guild is here every Saturday from 9:00 to 10:00am and can receive flowers. Call the office (Monday-Friday, 9:00am-5:00pm) to confirm your delivery time and make sure the office has the name and contact information for your florist.
